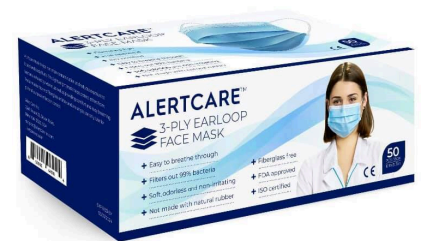

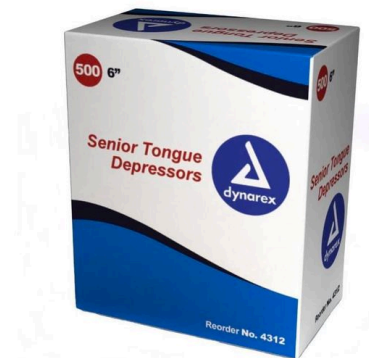
## Professional Plastic Wrap

*for eye wash*  
*If the client accidentally get anesthetic in the eyes, quickly rinse the eyes carefully with saline solution*

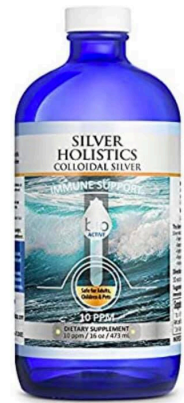




## Colloidal Silver

*to prep skin and continuously use during treatment*

*Can also be stored in fridge and be used the following days after treatment. Soak a cotton pad and cool the area with the colloidal silver.*



## Chlorhexidine

*for disinfection*

*Alcohol is flammable and should not be used with this procedure*



## Betadine/Iodine solution

*for treatments with Plaxel device to more easily see white dots*

*Make sure it doesn't contain any alcohol*

*The solution is antiseptic and bactericide. Wipe the area with solution before treatment. Easy to wipe off after treatment. Check allergy with client*

*Surgical smoke is produced by the thermal destruction of tissue. It has been shown to contain:*

- \* toxic gases*
- \* vapors and particulates*
- \* viable and non-viable cellular material*
- \* viruses*
- \* bacteria*



*The acute health effects can include:*

- \* irritation of respiratory system and eyes*
- \* headache*
- \* cough*
- \* nasal congestion*
- \* asthma and asthma-like symptoms*
